



notes on how to take clear finger prints

A BLURRED FINGER-PRINT HAS NO VALUE. ALL PRINT MUST BE AS CLEAR AS POSSIBLE

- ALWAYS enter particulars of person on finger-print form IMMEDIATELY AFTER taking his finger-prints. DO NOT take prints until you have done so.
- ALWAYS use the correct ink supplied. DO NOT USE ordinary ink or the ink on an inking pad for rubber stamps.
- Fingers must be clean and dry. If necessary, person having prints taken must wash hands.
- If fingers are badly worn, make smooth by using pumise stone. Remove oil or tar with benzine.
- Use a clean pad with no dust or old ink on it. Put ink on evenly - no lumps or blods. Do not use too much ink (this is a common fault.)
- All impressions must be in correct sequence to heading of space where prints is made, taken right down to the first joint of finger.
- All impressions are to be taken by ROLLING the fingers or thumbs, thus: The person having the print taken must let his hand go limp. Take each finger with nail towards you and roll on the paper so that the nail finishes away from him. CHECK prints to see that they not smeared.
- Check the separate prints of each finger with the prints of all four fingers taken together and so make sure you have taken the separate prints in the correct order.

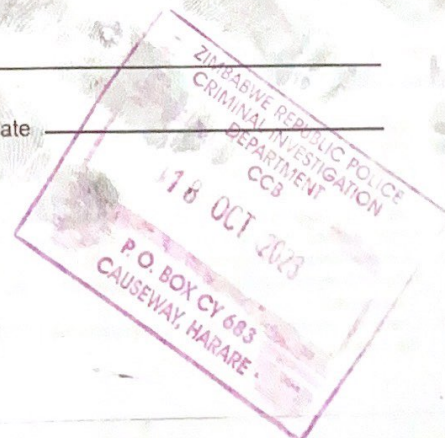
