Notes on how to take clear finger-prints

A BLURRED FINGER-PRINT HAS NO VALUE ALL PRINTS MUST BE AS CLEAR AS POSSIBLE

- ALWAYS enter particulars of the finger-print form IMMEDIATELY AFTER taking his finger-prints. DO NOT take another prints until you have done so.
- ALWAYS use the correct ink supplied. DO NOT use ordinary ink or the ink on any inking pad for rubber stamps
- Finger-prints must be clean and dry if necessary person having prints taken must wash hands
- If fingers are badly worn, make smooth by using pumice stone. Remove oil or tar with benzene
