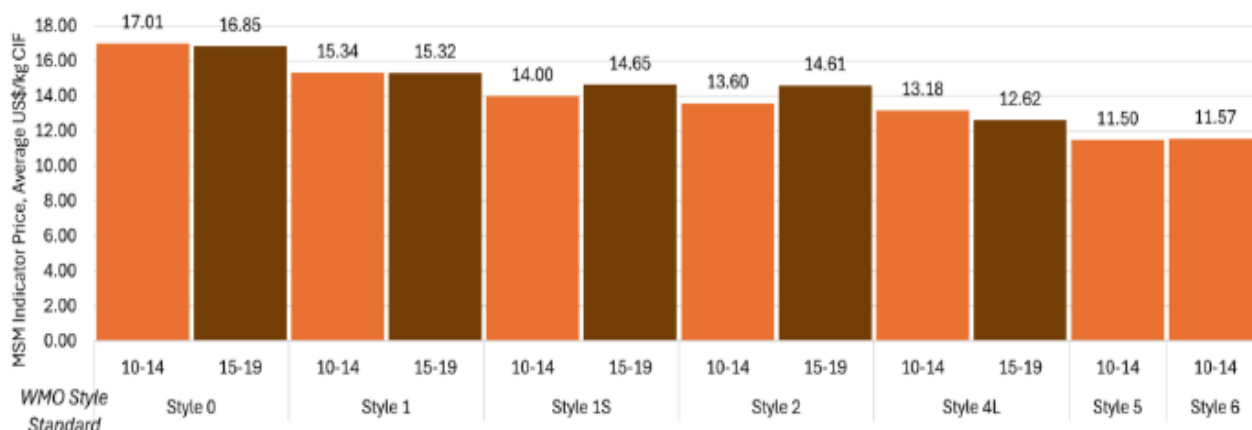

Macadamia Nuts Market Outlook

The graphs below compare prices in observed transactions in the most recent five-week period of 2025 (Weeks 15 to 19) with the previous five-week period (Weeks 10 to 14). In examining the comparison, kernel prices can be seen to have kept steady, with a rise in observed average prices seen for Styles 1S and Style 2.

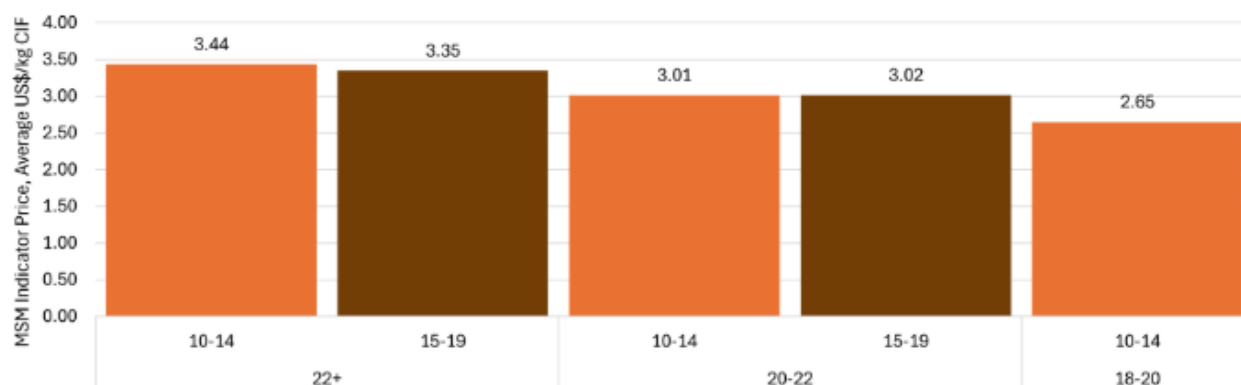
Average Kernel Prices by Style in 5 Week Intervals YTD

Average observed prices for NIS22+ declined over the two periods, while NIS20-22 prices remained steady.

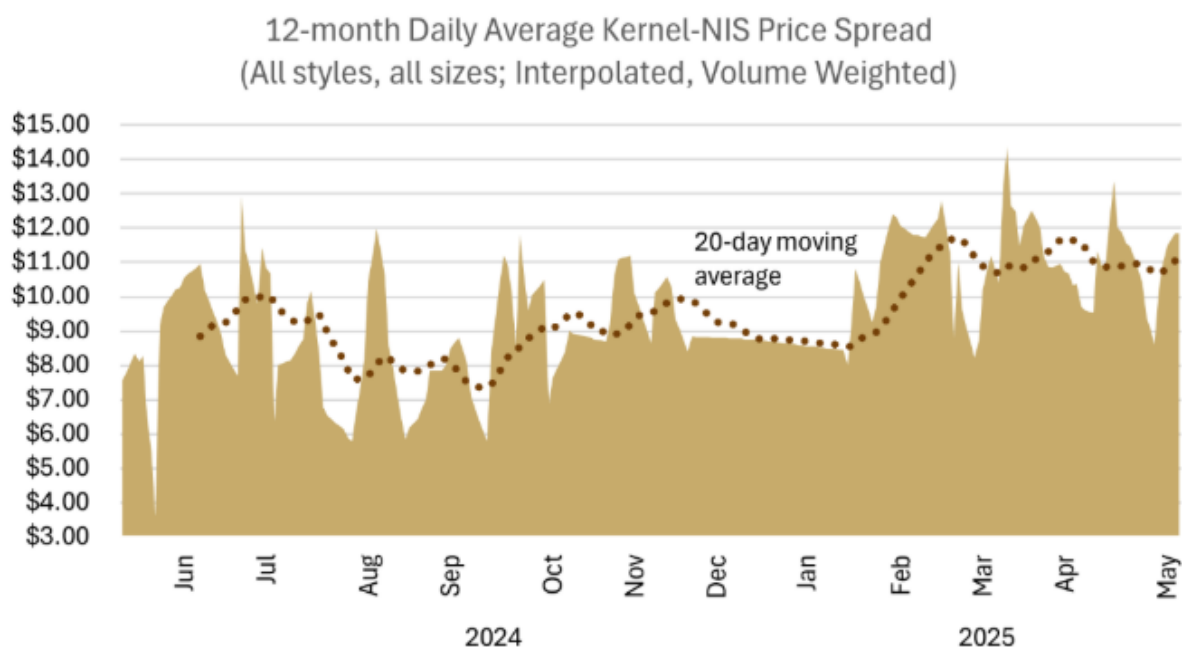
Average NIS Prices by Size in 5 Week Intervals YTD

The consistent price rally enjoyed by NIS20-22 since lows in October cooled towards the end of April, into May. NIS22+ prices have been more volatile this year, rising slightly since the beginning of the year. The narrowing gap between NIS20-22 and NIS22+ prices has been driven by demand for the former in onshore Chinese processing. The smaller nut cracks out smaller whole styles favoured by consumers in value-added products.

A strengthening of some kernel prices in May and a halt in the decline of others, has kept the kernel/NIS price spread steady into this month, after a slight narrowing in April. Given limited market visibility, MSM's volume-weighted daily average kernel/NIS price spread calculation should be read as an estimated trendline indicating direction and magnitude rather than as providing detailed statistics.

- The price of white maize increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$255.32/mt** last week to **US\$268.53/mt** this week.
- The price of yellow maize increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$228.51/mt** last week to **US\$232.62/mt** this week and decreased on the US GULF and CBOT markets from **US\$205.31/mt** and **US\$176.13/mt** last week to **US\$200.78/mt** and **US\$172.59/mt** this week respectively.
- The price of wheat (SRW) decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$351.99/mt** last week to **US\$350.85/mt** this week, increased on the US GULF market from **US\$215.32/mt** last week to **US\$217.61/mt** this week and remained constant on the CBOT market at **US\$190.70/mt**.
- The price of soya beans decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$405.63/mt** last week to **US\$399.67/mt** this week and increased on the US GULF and CBOT markets from **US\$407.86/mt** and **US\$380.15/mt** last week to **US\$419.70/mt** and **US\$392.06/mt** this week respectively.
- The price of sunflower seeds decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$484.11/mt** last week to **US\$482.87/mt** this week.
